Remember if you have any thoughts or suggestions contact one of the event crew or just come up and say hi at the next race. Brad



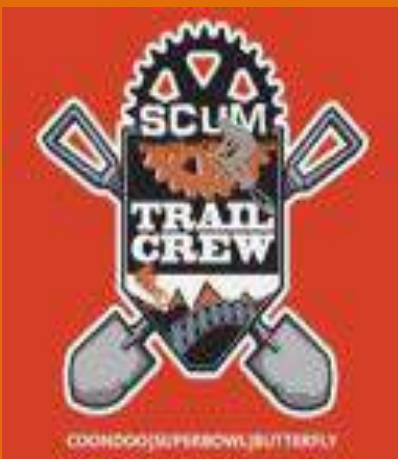
